**“Fear Not Little Flock: How Jesus Meets Us in Our Fears #3
Jesus and the Fear of Financial Loss”**

Luke 12:22-34

In order to follow Jesus, His first disciples had no promise of financial provision. Would they be able to cover their basic needs? In our passage today, Jesus speaks to the disciples, showing them why they did not need to be anxious about money (Luke 12:22). What an important message for us today. Almost everything we do, and everything we have, requires money and it is easy to imagine not having enough to cover our needs (Proverbs 23:4-5; Matthew 6:19). In our passage, Jesus shows that we have a hope that carries us through fear of financial loss by revealing the generosity of God, and the kingdom He has for those who seek it.

How do we overcome a fear of financial loss?

1. Keep Perspective: Remember Life is More than Possessions

(Luke 12:23, 29-31)

1 Timothy 6:6-8

2. Consider God's Care: How could He not provide for you?

(Luke 12:24-28)

3. Seek God's Kingdom: Take Practical Steps of Faith (Luke 12:31-34)

1 Timothy 6:17-19

Jesus didn't just speak about giving up everything to follow Him. He lived it. He gave up everything to save His people (2 Corinthians 8:9).

God proved His generosity and promise to you in sending His Son.

Do you have anything to fear?

Bible Study

(Luke 12:22-34)

1. Have you ever been afraid you wouldn't have enough money for something? What do think it would feel like to not have enough money for food?
2. Why do you think Jesus says, "life is more than food, and the body more than clothing" in verse 23?
3. Read verses 24-28. What comparison does Jesus make between us and birds and flowers? Why should this be encouraging?
4. In verses 25-26, Jesus says anxiety is pointless. Why? Can you think of ways that worry is also harmful?
5. In verses 29-31, Jesus uses the word "seek" three times. What are we to seek? What are we not to seek? What do we get when we seek the right thing?
6. When Jesus says to seek the kingdom, he is saying that we should honor God's lordship over our lives, that we should obey His commands, that we should profess faith in Christ, and that we should help others follow Him as well. Can you think how anxiety over money might stop a person from following Jesus?
7. Are there ways that anxiety over money is leading you away from God's kingdom? In generosity? In witnessing to others? In breaking a command? In fear of full surrender to God's call in your life?
8. What one way can you practically "seek the kingdom" and trust God will provide for you?
