Death's Defeat: How Jesus Overcomes the Fear of Death**John 11:1-44**

Every person on the face of this planet will confront death. No one comes out alive. Yet, because of the dark mystery of death, many don't like to talk or think about death. Many fear of the process of death, the leaving loved ones behind, the possibility of not entering, and disappointment in the promises. So they ignore it. Sadly, ignoring the realities of death also dim the realities the glory of heaven. In our passage today, we see how Jesus Himself becomes our hope in facing death. He has overcome it, and so we can prepare and hope.

1. Jesus and the Glory of God's Power (John 11:1-16)

2. Jesus and Our Hope in Death (John 11:17-27)

3. Jesus and the Grief of Death (John 11:28-37)

4. Jesus and the Death of Death (John 11:38-44)

By Jesus' victory over His own death, we find hope and answers to all our fears in death. Have you trusted Jesus Christ for your future?
