"Turning the Page for the New Year"

2 Corinthians 4:16-5:17

The daily monitoring of the COVID19 virus and the strain of a presidential election made for a trying and troublesome year. The hope of most Americans is that 2021 will turn the page resulting in a more "normal" daily life. But the future is determined by knowing in whom your identity is. Confusion about *who I am* results in confusion, perplexity, and aimlessness in approaching the future. Who am I? Our government increasingly views your identity as dependent on societal structures and cultural assumption not by individual decisions, hopes, and dreams. God determines who I am and He gives individual vision for the New Year and beyond. The cultural elites discourage personal hope by seeing everyone as a political class.

I. Who Am I? Created in the Image of God and For God

- A. Some do genetic tests to understand who they are
 - 1. Such tests do not go far enough back
 - 2. God created every person in His image to worship Him -Genesis 1:26-28
- B. God created every human person
 - 1. All people have been created from "one blood" Acts 17:26-28
 - 2. God has a plan for each individual and determines the boundaries of people groups Deuteronomy 32:8; Genesis 11:6-9

II. Who Am I? - Born With A Deadly Virus

- A. That infects all humanity Romans 5:12-14
 - 1. All Have sinned no exceptions! Romans 3:23
 - 2. Sin is not exclusive to a race or a group
 - 3. Physical and temporal suffering is the result of sin Romans 8:20-22
 - 4. Suffering is to hope in God
- B. Sin and its consequence unite all people
 - 1. Hope is freely offered to all Romans 5:17-19
 - 2. Grace will reign through righteousness Romans 5:20-21

III. Who Am I? - A New Creature in Christ - 2 Corinthians 5:17

- A. My identity is not from
 - 1. Any physical feature
 - 2. Or from sin
- B. I am a Christian
 - 1. Bought with a price 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
 - 2. I belong to Christ 1 John 3:1-3

Don't let anyone or any government rob you of your inheritance

IV. Who Am I? - A Citizen of Heaven

- A. I have eternal life in my soul
 - 1. A guaranteed home in heaven John 14:1-4
 - 2. An inheritance incorruptible and does not fade away 1 Peter 1:3-9
- B. A new resurrection body
 - 1. A resurrection to life John 5:26-29
 - 2. Citizenship in heaven Philippians 3:20-21

Who Am I! – Made in God's image, infected with a deadly virus, a new creature in Christ, a citizen of heaven!
