“All Things to All People”

1 Corinthians 9:19-23

Before He left this world, Jesus instructed His disciples to make disciples of all nations (Matthew 28:19-20), especially by sharing the gospel so more people could believe the message. Yet so few Christians actively share their faith. In our passage today, we will see the beliefs that are critical for getting started in sharing our faith.

1. Evangelistic Responsibility (*1 Corinthians 9:19*)

We need to see that we each have a responsibility to share the good news.

2. Evangelistic Relationships (*1 Corinthians 9:20-22*)

We need to be intentional in our efforts to share the good news.

3. Evangelistic Reward (*1 Corinthians 9:15-18*)

We need to anticipate the reward of sharing the good news.

The greatest evangelist in the world is Jesus Christ. He took it upon Himself to save you. He became a man to relate with you. He has seen your salvation as His great reward (Hebrews 12:2). As you praise Jesus for doing this in your life, pray that you could bring this news to the lives of others.
