The Power of the Gospel*1 Corinthians 15:1-11*

If we are going to effectively solve our problems, we have to get to the source. Just bouncing from symptom to symptom will not solve problems; we need to get at the root. For the last 9 months, we have been looking at the problems in the church at Corinth. Today we start on the final problem: their misunderstandings of the gospel, particularly the resurrection of Jesus (1 Corinthians 15:12). What if this problem was behind all of the rest? Today we will see how the gospel is the power for living, and the power behind solving our problems. What is the gospel?

1. The Gospel is the Power of God for Salvation *(1 Corinthians 15:1-4)*

Romans 6:23

Genesis 3:15

Isaiah 53:4-6

Romans 5:6

Psalm 16:10

2. The Gospel is Historical *(1 Corinthians 15:3-8)*

John 20:24-29

3. The Gospel Transforms *(1 Corinthians 15:9-11)*

The gospel is the good news that Jesus has conquered sin and has brought us into His kingdom. The gospel is the power of God for salvation and the power to solve life's problems with God's power. It reminds us that we are more sinful than we know, but more loved than we can imagine.
